Dear Graduate,

Auditions for the TPA Graduation Student Presentations will be held on Thursday, February 4th, 2010 from 6:30-8:30 p.m. at the Wichita Bible Church (633 S. Woodlawn). **Candidates should be prepared to audition with the presentation, i.e. the song, speech, drama presentation, dance, etc., that they would be performing at graduation.**

- The recommended length for each presentation is less than 5 minutes. Final time limits will be up to the TPA Graduation Steering Committee's discretion and the nature of the presentation. If a presentation is over 5 minutes in length, cuts may be required. Please make sure the presentation is appropriate for a graduation ceremony. Do not come unprepared!
- If you are preparing a musical presentation and need an accompanist, that accompanist must be present and audition with you.
- **All candidates MUST contact the Student Presentation Chairman no later than January 30th** and must provide information concerning the nature of the presentation and pertinent information including: title/composer/arranger of any music to be performed and any special needs, i.e., sound system, microphone, piano, etc. Potential speakers and dramatic presentation, etc., need to send a copy of their presentation to the Student Presentation Chairman also by January 30th. We prefer that this be sent as a Word document via email. If that is not possible, please mail it by January 30th to the address listed below.
- After contacting the Student Presentation Chairman, each candidate will be required to submit a resume of their experience in the area they are performing.

The TPA Graduation Steering Committee, along with other qualified individuals, will select the students for the ceremony. Individuals and/or groups consisting of graduates solely from the class of 2010 will be given priority. The committee could make exceptions in unique circumstances, i.e., family groups, organized homeschool groups, etc.

Student or students selected will receive necessary advice, guidance and practice assistance from the committee in preparation for their presentation on Graduation Day.
